OBJECTIVES:

The objectives of the ASAS Global Network Forum are:

- To communicate the status and facilitate discussion on global efforts to advance research, development, integration, and implementation of ASAS into future air traffic management architecture.
- To identify intersecting research and development needs for ASAS enabled applications and develop practical strategies for cooperation.
- To identify global ASAS related operational and technical interfaces, and develop practical strategies to ensure global interoperability of selected ASAS related hardware, software, operational concepts and procedures.
- To identify roadblocks and suggest strategies to accelerate ASAS equipage and implementation to obtain quick benefits.
- To suggest strategies that will minimize impact to air travelers and maximize benefit to aircraft operators and air navigation service providers, taking consideration for international agreements and regulatory requirements.
- To identify issues and strategize solutions relating to the use of ASAS enabled GS and AS applications in a future air traffic management environment.

TRANSPORTATION

Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD) is the nearest airport. For transportation between the airport and the hotel, you may use a shuttle, taxi, or public transportation.

Shuttle

Coach USA Wisconsin offers hourly service from 8 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Allow at least 1 hour for travel time. Pickup at O'Hare is at the Bus Shuttle Center. The one-way is \$13.00. Round-Trip fare is \$23.00.

Taxi

Taxicabs are available on a first come, first serve basis from the lower level curb front of all terminals. Shared ride service is available. There are no flat rates because all taxicabs run on meters. Expect to spend approximately \$35 to \$40 for a taxicab ride to the Fairmont.

Public Transportation
